(MIAMI, FL – November 15, 2018) – <u>Art Miami</u>, America's foremost contemporary and modern art fair, and its sister fair CONTEXT Art Miami will return for their respective 29<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> installments at Art Week in Miami, Florida. This year's fairs will kick-off on Tuesday, December 4<sup>th</sup> with a private VIP preview evening, before opening to the public on December 5<sup>th</sup> and continuing through December 9<sup>th</sup>.

The Platinum VIP Preview will take place on December 4<sup>th</sup> from 4:30PM – 5:30PM to benefit the **Pérez Art Museum Miami (PAMM)**, sponsored by **Christie's International Real Estate**. This will be the first opportunity for collectors, curators, museum professionals, interior designers and art world luminaries to acquire the finest investment quality modern and contemporary works by established, emerging, and cutting-edge artists from more than 250 international galleries. The VIP Preview will then continue for all VIP cardholders from 5:30PM to 10PM. For the second year, the fairs will be held at the prestigious waterfront location of One Miami Herald Plaza on Biscayne Bay, within walking distance of Museum Park and The Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Arts, nestled between the Venetian and MacArthur Causeways in the heart of Downtown Miami.

On Thursday, December 6<sup>th</sup>, Art Miami and **Chef Daniel Boulud** will host a special four-course dinner with wine pairings to celebrate Art Miami 2018 Lifetime Visionary Award recipients **Mr. and Mrs. Dennis and Debra Scholl** for their contributions to the cultural landscape of Miami.
